The parliamentary launch of the list is an important chance to remind MPs of the chance that the UK has to help protect people's freedom of religion, right across the world (whether they're Christians or not – see Christian Solidarity Worldwide for why this is important). Right across the world, Covid-19 has made persecution worse for so many disciples. And the World Watch List draws attention to the 50 countries where persecution is at its most extreme.
